

Austin Police Operation Blue Santa Volunteer Waiver and Obligations

- I release and forever discharge and hold harmless Austin Police Operation Blue Santa from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from volunteer services provided by myself and/or the group I am representing.
- It is understood and acknowledged that this Release discharges Austin Police Operation Blue Santa from any liability or claim that may arise with respect to bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from services provided for the warehouse shift.
- Further it is understood that Austin Police Operation Blue Santa assumes no responsibility for or obligation to provide financial or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health or disability benefits or insurance of any nature in the event of volunteer injury, illness, death or damage to property. Any such claim for compensation or liability on the part of the participating entities is expressly waived.
- Austin Police Operation Blue Santa is hereby released and forever discharged from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first-aid treatment or other medical services rendered in connection with an emergency during volunteer service.
- It is understood that volunteer services provided at the Austin Police Operation Blue Santa warehouse may include activities that may be hazardous. The Austin Police Operation Blue Santa is free from all liability for injury, illness, death, or property damage resulting from volunteer services rendered during the volunteer shift.
- All right, title, and interests in any and all photographs, images, video, audio in connection with providing volunteer services for the volunteer shift is granted and conveyed to Austin Police Operation Blue Santa.
- It is expressly agreed that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Texas and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas. It is agreed that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release is deemed invalid, the enforceability of the remaining provisions of this Release shall not be affected.
- I understand masks are required in the warehouse, which is a City of Austin facility. Please visit cityspace.austintexas.gov/Emergency-Information or send questions/concerns to COAEPQ@austintexas.gov
- I agree to a covid test (nasal swab, 1/2" insert into both nostrils) before entering the Blue Santa warehouse for volunteer service.
- By registering for an Austin Police Operation Blue Santa warehouse shift, the intent to enter into this Release and Waiver of Liability is willingly and voluntarily understood and accepted. Agree
- Parking occurs on S. Industrial Dr. and/or on Commercial Ctr. Dr.
- I understand that I cannot bring children under 12 years of age.
- I agree to wear close-toed shoes to protect my feet.
- Only one shift per agency or business will be accepted without prior approval or invitation.
- It is understood that my shift may be cancelled depending on unforeseen changes in workload.
